- ✓ Re-organization of the timetable to ensure social distancing.
- ✓ Reduced hostel accommodation by half due to social distancing.
- ✓ Recruitment of a full time nurse to work alongside the Clinical Officer.
- ✓ Provided a temporary isolation facility.
- ✓ Construction of a Sanatorium is on-going.
- ✓ Access control thermal cameras at the gate to capture face, check wearing of facemasks and take temperature.
- ✓ Communication on COVID-19 protocols through posters and banners in all strategic areas.
